### Seeding Rates

A seeding rate of 350-450 pounds per acre or 8-10 pounds per 1000 square feet. Half of those rates for overseeding. A seeding depth of 1/8"-1/4" is best for establishment. Germination will occur after 7-10 days under ideal conditions. First mowing should occur within 30 days from time of seeding.
