

AUGUST 21 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT PIUS X, POPE: Pius X, formerly Giuseppe Sarto, was born in Italy in 1835. At age 23 he was ordained a priest and was involved in pastoral ministry for 17 years. He became a bishop in 1884, a cardinal in 1892, and was elected pope in 1903. He died in 1914 and was canonized in 1954. His recommendations and encyclicals reflect his pastoral background: he advocated frequent communion for adults, sacramental preparation for children, and catechism instruction for everyone.

AUGUST 22 - MEMORIAL OF THE QUEENSHIP OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY: In

1954, Pope Pius XII instituted this memorial "so that all may clearly recognize and more zealously venerate the kind and maternal rule of the Mother of God" (Ad Caeli Reginam). This memorial is celebrated on the Octave of the Solemnity of the Assumption.
