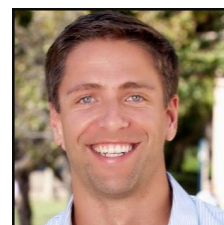

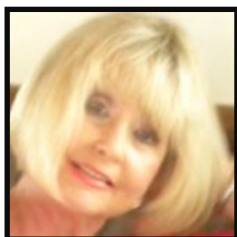

New 2018 Laws for California or should I say, Taxafornia?

SB -1 increases your gas tax 20 cents (Nov.1) and your vehicle license fees by an average of \$100.00. (Jan1)

Cap -n- Trade Tax passed which will increase gas to 0.63 to 93 cents a gallon change and the taxes that go with it...The math projection is ... $(0.12 + 0.63 = 075/\text{gallon} + \text{current } \$3.10/\text{gallon} = \$3.85/\text{gallon})$...We're already the costliest in the nation.

Proposed increase on a new tax every resident will pay for tap water.

A new \$50.00 charge for all residents residing in Mobil Home Parks to address the "living condition enforcement" in those parks!

A \$3.46 parks bond to pay for parks in "disadvantaged communities", meaning Los Angeles. Some money goes to help fix the Salton Sea which should have always been a State responsibility.

Law to release any lifer (murder, rape, child molestation, etc.) who is 60 years old and has already served 25 years in prison. That means Charles Manson would have qualified had he not died! The Melendez brothers who killed their parents could be released in 12 years.

A new bill to require our true gender be omitted from our drivers license.

Free legal services for illegal immigrants.

Establish safe "injection zones" run by the government to oversee people injecting heroin.

Give preferential treat to prisoners convicted of serious crimes that are less than 25 years old because their brains are not mature enough to understand right from wrong.

Blackmail Tesla to either unionize with the United Auto Workers Union, or forfeit State incentives to buy their electric cars.

THE NAKED COMMUNIST

(45 goals to destroy the United States of America)



On Jan. 10, 1963, Congressman Albert S. Herlong Jr. of Florida read a list of 45 Communist goals into the Congressional Record. The list was derived from researcher, and former FBI Agent, Cleon Skousen's book, The Naked Communist.

These goals are well worth revisiting after 55 years to see how many have been attained and how the elites of our country still strive to implement them today.

- ✓ • Develop the illusion that total disarmament by the United States would be a demonstration of moral strength.
- ✓ • Permit free trade between all nations and regardless of whether or not items could be used for war.
- ✓ • Recognize Red China and work for the admission of Red China to the U.N.
- ✓ • Promote the U.N. and demand it be set up as a one-world government with its own independent armed forces. (Europe)
- ✓ • Do away with all loyalty oaths.
- ✓ • Capture one or both of the political parties in the United States.
- ✓ • Use decisions of courts to weaken basic American institutions by claiming their activities violate civil rights.
- ✓ • Get control of the schools. Use them as transmission belts for socialism and current Communist propaganda. Soften the curriculum. Get control of teachers' associations.
- ✓ • Use student riots to foment public protests against programs and organizations. Gain control of student newspapers on college campuses.
- ✓ • Infiltrate the press. Get control of editorial writing, policy-making positions.
- ✓ • Gain control of key positions in radio, TV, and motion pictures.
- ✓ • Eliminate laws governing obscenity, calling them "censorship" and a violation of free speech and free press.
- ✓ • Break down cultural standards of morality by promoting pornography and obscenity in books, magazines, motion pictures, radio, and TV. Present degeneracy and promiscuity as "normal, natural, and healthy."
- ✓ • Infiltrate the churches and replace formal religion with "social" religion. Discredit the Bible and emphasize the need for intellectual maturity, which does not need a "religious crutch."
- ✓ • Eliminate prayer or any phase of religious expression in the schools on the ground that it violates the principle of "separation of church and state."
- ✓ • Discredit the American Constitution by calling it inadequate, old-fashioned, out of step with modern needs.
- ✓ • Discredit the American Founding Fathers. Present them as selfish aristocrats who had no concern for the "common man."
- ✓ • Belittle all forms of American culture and discourage the teaching of American history on the ground that it was only a minor part of the "big picture."
- ✓ • Support any socialist movement to give centralized control over any part of the culture: education, social agencies, welfare programs, health clinics, etc.
- ✓ • Eliminate the House Committee on Un-American Activities.
- ✓ • Infiltrate and gain control of unions.
- ✓ • Discredit the family as an institution. Encourage promiscuity and easy divorce.
- ✓ • Create impression that violence and insurrection are legitimate aspects of the American tradition; that students and special-interest groups should rise up & use united force to solve economic, political or social problems.
- ✓ • Internationalize the Panama Canal.
- ✓ • Give the World Court jurisdiction over nations and individuals alike. (European Union)

Only in America are legal citizens labeled “racists” and “Nazis”, but illegal aliens are called “Dreamers”.

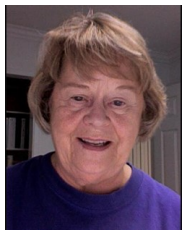
How can the Federal Government ask U.S. Citizens to pay back student loans – when illegal aliens are receiving free education?

He currently hosts the podcasts "Christian Parenting" and "In Pursuit of Virtue". Slater was named Top 5 "Young Guns" of Talk Radio by TALKERS Magazine. Slater recently conducted a 90-minute interview with Donald Trump in his Trump Tower boardroom.

Mike speaks to the Conservative heart by focusing on the 5 values that most inspire a virtuous life: curiosity, gratitude, hope, zest and love. Where other talk hosts may use anger, frustration and hopelessness to talk about current events, Slater tells stories that connect to eternal principles and conservative values.
