MASS READING REFLECTION

March 24, 2019

1st Reading Ex 20 : 1-17 or 20: 1-3, 7,8 12-17

[Ten Commandments]

Since civil and religious laws were intimately intertwined in Hebrew culture, we must read the laws of the Old Testaments with this in mind. Civil laws and laws clearly conditioned by time and culture (e.g. dietary laws) do not bind us any longer. The Ten Commandments, however, are timeless. Millions of Christians and Jews alike live by these laws. There is not only human but also divine wisdom imbedded in them.

But, remember, in observing laws, we Christians should be motivated by love: "You did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received a spirit of adoption, through which we cry, Abba, 'Father'" (Rom8:15).

2nd Reading 1 Cor 1:22-25 [Christ, the Power of God]

Jews demand "signs" (Gospel). They want the spectacular. Greeks want "wisdom" Everything must be clearly understandable. There is no room for intuition, vision, mystery. It may be that Paul's Jews and Greeks characterize two kinds of Christians.

The first comprises those who hanker for the spectacular in worship. It must be exciting, or else they will not come. They are people who ask, "What does a worship service offer me? And not, "What can I do to make it meaningful?" The second comprises the rationalists who crave wisdom, analysis, insight, but do not realize that values like mystery, intuition, love, or faith cannot be analyzed without being destroyed. Paul offers his vision of both groups, namely, the cross, Christ crucified. What is your stand? There is a law of Worship (First Reading; Gospel).

Third Sunday of Lent



Theme: Laws and Worship

We are proud to be a nation ruled by laws and not by whims of individuals. There is much wisdom invested in our Constitution and in most of our other laws as well. But when we permit things to get out of control and do not let the laws work as was intended by the founding fathers, the country is in trouble. However, when the insight that we are a nation under the laws prevails once again, and we let the system work, we recover from setbacks.

Today's Scripture deals with laws (First Reading), deviation from them (Gospel), and the reaction by a man who was concerned. We must be careful, though, not to regard God's commandments as mere civil laws. In our relation to God, we Christians see ourselves in a family setting. The wish of a father who cares for his children is not a law in the same sense as a law found in our civil code of laws. We are related to God as children to a loving father.

There is one absolute rule we go by and that is love for God and neighbor, Other commandments derive their reason for existence only from the law of love (Mt 22-40), and we should understand them in the light of Jesus' Sermon on the Mount (Mt 5). Obedience to the commandments should always be motivated by love!
