

TOWN OF ELBRIDGE
TOWN BOARD MEETING
FEBRUARY 28th, 2019

The Town Board of the Town of Elbridge met to conduct their regular meeting on Thursday, February 24th, 2019 at 7PM at the Town Municipal Building, 5 Route 31, Jordan, N. Y.

Supervisor Richardson opened the meeting at 7 and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

PRESENT: Councilor Rita Dygert, Councilor Doug Blumer, Councilor Floyd Duger, Councilor Mike Caron, and Supervisor Vern Richardson.

OTHERS PRESENT: Highway Superintendent Jim White, Code Officer Howard Tanner, Town Attorney Scott Chatfield, and Clerk Deb Stapleton.

ADOPT MINUTES: On a motion of Councilor Dygert seconded by Councilor Caron the minutes from February 14th, 2019 were approved.

MOTION TO PAY BILLS: On a motion of Councilor Caron, seconded by Councilor Duger- General Bills Abstract #2, Vouchers #60-115, in the amount of \$425,113.36 were ordered paid, and Highway Bills, Abstract #2, Vouchers #1020-1037, in the amount of \$24,114.58 were ordered paid with a total disbursement of \$449,227.94.

COMMUNICATIONS:

- 1) Codes report.

Code Officer Tanner addressed the board with a comparison list of what other towns, similar in size to Elbridge, charge for fees including building permits, subdivisions, variances, and site plans. BP Extensions, sheds, signs, inspections and flood plains were also discussed. Burn permits need to be addressed and eliminated. There are two training sessions coming up. March 11th- 14th and April 2nd- 4th. Every code cycle, more trips are added to inspection lists.
