Course Description:

This 8-hour course will expose students to advanced applications of the carbine with an emphasis on weapon familiarity, manipulations, marksmanship, movement and speed. Topics include: economy of movement; establishing a zero; marksmanship fundamentals; cover/barricades; alternate positions; support side shooting and malfunction remediation; cleaning and maintenance procedures.

Students must provide their own kit and ammo—300 rounds of pistol and 500 rounds of rifle

Course Objectives:

At the end of this program, students will:

- ♦ Zero a weapon
- ♦ Understand Ballistics - twist rates, barrel lengths, muzzle velocity, environmental effects and effects once the bullet hits the target
- ♦ Describe shooting fundamentals – stance, grip, sight picture/alignment, trigger and breathing.
- ♦ Perform a variety of drills including rifle zero confirmation, ready -up, support side, reloads, rifle-pistol transitions, shoulder transitions, malfunctions, barricades and grid of fire.

Who Should Attend:

- ♦ Law enforcement officers
- ♦ SWAT officers

Instructor:

Rich Saito is assigned full-time to a SWAT team in Florida and to the U.S. Marshals Fugitive Task Force. He has over ten years of SWAT experience in over 1000 tactical operations. Rich is currently a sniper team leader and SWAT training coordinator.
