SHOW PART A ~ FRIDAY ~ OCTOBER 23RD

- To be held in the same ring as State Fair Goat Showmanship Classes
- Show to start no sooner than 2pm or 30 minutes after the conclusion of the State Fair Breeding Goat Show
- **SHOW ORDER:** Showmanship Oldest to Youngest followed by PeeWee & Newbies Showmanship Classes - Market Goats - Commercial Does - Percentage Boer Does - Fullblood Boer Does - Boer Bucks Division 1 Percentage bucks followed by Division 2 Fullblood Bucks.
- **SPECIAL NOTE:** There will not be showmanship classes on Saturday. All JLGA Showmanship Classes are held on Friday as stated above.

SHOW PART B ~ SATURDAY ~ OCTOBER 24TH

- Same ring as Show A on Friday. In the event our Saturday show has to change to another ring, an announcement will be made on our Face Book page.
- Show starts at 9am
- **SHOW ORDER:** AOB Does - AOB Bucks - AOB Companion Wethers - Pygmy Does - Pygmy Bucks - Nigerian Dwarf Does - Dairy Bucks Division 1 Registered Grade, Experimentals, & Mini Dairy Breeds - Dairy Bucks Division 2 ADGA recognized Dairy Breeds - Dairy Does Division 1 Registered Grade, Experimentals, & Mini Dairy Breeds - Dairy Does Division 2 ADGA recognized Dairy Breeds.

PRE-REGISTRATION FEES, DEADLINE, & LATE FEE ENTRIES:

- **DEADLINE FOR PRE-ENTRY FOR THIS SHOW IS SUNDAY OCTOBER 18 NO LATER THAN MIDNIGHT.** Please visit our website at www.jlga.org to submit pre-registration forms. Please remember to note the day of your arrival & if you will need any extra pens. Pens are allotted based on a minimum of 3 goats per pen. Please see show specific rules below.
- Showmanship Members \$5 per youth ~ Non-Members \$10 per youth
- Goat Classes Members \$15 per entry ~ Non-Members \$20 per youth
- JLGA Memberships can be purchased at time of Check-in. All JLGA Memberships purchased at the State Fair will roll over through the 2016 JLGA Show Season.
- JLGA Memberships are \$20 per youth per year ~ \$25 for Breeder youth per year ~ \$50. Family Membership for 3+ youth in the same immediate family.
- Late Entry fees of \$2.00 per entry including showmanship entries apply after above mentioned deadline.
- Pre-registration cuts down your wait time in line & saves on late fees. It also helps get the show started on time.

CHECK-IN & REGISTRATION AT THE STATE FAIR FOR BOTH SHOW DATES:

- **ALL FEES ARE DUE AT TIME OF CHECK-IN**
- All Check-in locations will be near the State Fair Goat Showmanship Ring.
- Wednesday October 21st ~ 11am to 2:15 pm. Then again following the "Dress Your Goat" Competition till 7pm.
- Thursday October 22nd 10am to 2pm during State Fair Breeding Goat Showmanship.
- Friday October 23rd 10am to Noon.
- Saturday October 24th 8am to 8:30am

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING SECTION CAREFULLY! SPECIFIC RULES FOR THIS SHOW ONLY!

- Shavings must be purchased at the State Fair
- For this show only, please make sure to note on your pre-registration the following:
Whether or not you are also participating in the State Fair Goat Shows
Your date of arrival
Number of Pens requested
- You may need to bring your own dividers. Minimum number of goats per pen is 3. Pens will be assigned based on your total number of goats being brought. There may or may not be extra pens available. This will not be known till after the conclusion of the "Dress Your Goat" Competition when all State Fair Goats have been checked in. ***PLEASE DO NOT move goats into empty pens before you have been assigned extra pens.***
- If you are also participating in the State Fair Goats Shows, you may bring any extra goats you have that are showing in the JLGA shows only. However, those goats must be housed within your allotted assigned State Fair Pens until it is determined if there are extra pens available as stated above.
- Also please remember if you are bringing older bucks to show in the JLGA show, that the State Fair pens are short & you may need to put a top on the pens to prevent them from jumping out. If a buck presents a problem with jumping out, they will have to be moved over to the horse barn in taller stalls.
- Please remember that Showmanship for this show, Show #6 will be on Friday at the start of Part A JLGA Show. THERE WILL NOT BE Showmanship classes in Saturday's Part B Show.
- If you are only planning to come to Friday's Part A of the JLGA show, it is suggested you come on Thursday evening if possible, as they will be admitting Market Steers on Friday Morning. You may arrive on Friday morning, just please be prepared for possible delays in waiting to unload.
- If you are only planning to come to Saturday's Part B of the JLGA show, you may arrive Friday or wait to arrive on Saturday morning early. Please remember show starts at 9am & check-in will be from 8-830am.
- Due to the fact that there are lots of State Fair Activities going on at the same time as the JLGA Show including other species shows & other activities such as the Quiz bowl, JLGA participants that are also competing in these State Fair Competitions may get another youth to show their goats while they are gone. They must arrange this ahead of time & make sure the youth helping them knows when they will be needed. Youth that will be absent from the JLGA ring for the above reasons, must check-in at the

JLGA Show Desk before they leave & upon their return. As soon as they return, they must take back over their goats. If the goats are in the middle of a class or a Champion Drive, then they must wait till after that class or drive is completed to take back over.
