Choose how far you want to go before you turn around to return to the parking area. Turn around distances of 5, 10, 15, or 20 miles. **Parking and Launch Area:** The junction of County C and Forest Rd. 236, take Co. C approximately 10 miles from Washburn or Cornucopia. Park just off F.R. 236.
