29TH WINTER CARNIVAL OF DANCE

Our annual Winter Carnival of Dance was a terrific success thanks to all the students, families, and friends who lent their support to our charity event.

The Dance Center stages this show each holiday season to raise money for Fairborn FISH, an organization designed to help the less fortunate people of Fairborn. This year, we are proud to report, the Winter Carnival raised a whopping \$4700 and hundreds of food and non-perishable items for FISH.

Beth Player, the FISH Coordinator, sent MVDC a letter of thanks addressed to Miss Kelly, Teachers, and Students that read, in part, "Miami Valley Dance Center is the BEST! Every year, FISH Fairborn benefits from your generous donation of money and canned goods. You help us finish the year off and start the next one with enough money to buy food for a month or two and lots of canned goods to keep us from spending the money too fast.

This year the need for our services continues as we get new families that need help. FISH is serving between 550-600 families at the pantry each month. Through November of this year, we have fed 20,182 people. With your donation we will continue to be able to feed even more people as this year ends and the next one begins.

CALLING ALL MEN!

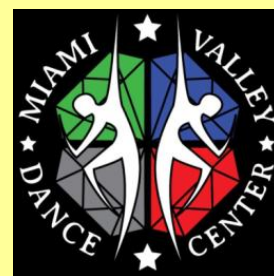

ets to both shows, the Dropbox link to the music, and recital souvenir.

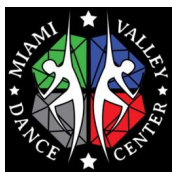

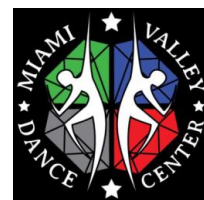

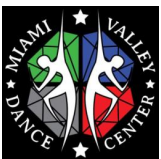
