Frank I. Miller, 91, of Caseville died Monday, Oct. 2, 2000, at Huron Memorial Hospital in Bad Axe. He was born Sept. 6, 1909, in Sigel Township at the home of his parents, the late John and Lucy (Rumptz) Miller. On Nov. 19, 1932, he was united in marriage to Agnes Andreski at St. Michael's Catholic Church, Port Austin.
