- 1 This tournament is open to all South Sound USBC Youth Members. Youth bowlers are required to show their USBC card at check in
2. Entering averages will be used in the following order:
 - a. Highest South Sound USBC 2015-2016 certified book average of 21 games or more
 - b. Highest USBC book average of at least 21 games from the previous season
 - c. If no 2015-2016 certified average, current average of at least 9 games as of November 1 2016 will be used
 - d. In the event a bowler has a standard and a sport league average, rule 201C in the USBC Playing Rule Book must be observed. It is the bowler's responsibility to use the USBC conversion chart to adjust average. The higher of the two will then be used
 - e. USBC rule 319a (2) - 10 pin rule does not apply
 - f. Failure to report an accurate average that results in a divisional change may result in disqualification

- 3 Handicap will be 100% of 220. Average divisions will be as follows

- 4 Teams will consist of 4 members. Bowlers may participate in the Team & doubles events more than once. At least two (2) of the bowlers must be different in the Team Event and one (1) in the Doubles event. You can only participate once in the Singles event. For All Events your first scores in each event will be used
- 5 Entry fee is \$12.00 per person per event. Lineage & expense is \$9.50 and scholarship awards \$2.50. Scholarship awards will be given on a 1:5 ratio in each division. (SMART Account #9009) Any added scholarship money will be pro-rated per division. First place winners in each division and scratch all events will receive a plaque at the SSUSBC Annual Awards Banquet
6. Entries close at 11:30 AM on November 6, 2016. Squads are filled on a first come, first served basis.
7. Tournament directors must be notified of any changes (substitutes) at check in. The line up that you submit will be the line-up at the start of each event
8. All bowlers must check in dress code compliant 30 minutes prior to squad start time
9. **Dress attire must be neat, clean and proper fitting. Collared shirts or USBC or SSUSBC official youth jersey and slacks, Bermuda shorts, Capri's, skirts or skorts must be worn. Skirts and skorts must be to the end of fingers when arms held to side. Tournament Director must approve any/all exceptions. Tournament Director's decision is final.**
10. If there is an error in scoring, contact a tournament official immediately. All other conflicts with the general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than 30 minutes after the completion of each event that the conflict was in. Any protest must be confirmed in writing to the South Sound USBC within 72 hours after completion of the tournament. Each protest under this Rule must be specific in itself
11. Misconduct/Poor Sportsmanship on or off the lanes during the tournament competition will **NOT** be tolerated. This can result in disqualification from the tournament and forfeiture of entry fee, position and any scholarship prize. This rule will be enforced at the discretion of the tournament director and committee
12. Bowlers arriving late shall begin play with the frame being bowled, Frames missed will be credited with zeros.
13. This tournament will be certified. USBC Youth rules and regulations will govern this tournament
