

Minutes of August 15, 2022

The Huntington Township Trustees met in a regular scheduled meeting at 7:00 PM with the pledge of Allegiance. Attendees: Walter Rollin, Robert Holmes, Jed Lamb, Sheila Lanning, Matt Combs, Frances Rollin and Carl Strekely. *Motion* by Lamb with a second by Rollin to approve the minutes of August 1, 2022 as written. Roll call: three yeas. Checks 10023-10032 and payments totaling \$5,910.40 were approved for payment.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

WATER BOARD- Lamb: not raised tap fee since 2015, struggling to keep up with supplies, they stopped charging a fee for paying by credit card

LORCO- Lamb: busy with new construction and developments. Accepted bid for pipeline for West Salem and Cinnamon Lake, most of the project paid with American Rescue Plan Act money and some from Ashland.

AMBULANCE- Holmes: still waiting on defibrillator delivery, Hank doing good, looking to hire.

FIRE- Rollin: outfitting two new trucks, still looking to refurbish big trucks. Mr. Pitts doing well, received three applications for new lieutenant.

OPWC / SWAC: Combs: talking with Shawn about culvert on Stewart Road just west of West Road about how to apply for money.

ZONING- Received one resume and one phone call, Butch to call Bursley Road person and everyone to review the resume.

OFFICE ON AGING- Call from Brittany at office on aging about helping Shirley Whitney of SR 162 with mailbox issue. Rollin: couldn't reach Brittany yet.

CEMETERY- *Motion* by Rollin with a second by Lamb to refund Midwest Everlasting for \$275.00 for foundation on lot #102 West for Prante. There appears to have been an existing foundation on the lot making the new foundation not necessary. Roll call: 3 yeas. Rollin: received contact about wreaths across America, Cathy and Clyde Workman are looking to buy a single lot. Lanning: no contact yet from the Workman's, Richard McConnell buying double lot #117 West, found the ancestor of Mr. Rollins (Freida Hines Bruce) on lot #418 EAST with her mother (Beatrice Long). Combs: still looking at ways to switch headstones in EAST Cemetery as requested by Mr. Bates.

ROADS and EQUIPMENT: Lanning: need prevailing wage statements and signed contract to pay Erie Blacktop for chip and seal work. Lamb: don't need prevailing wage on projects under \$75,000.00. Rollin: received call from Sullivan Township about using road grader because their grader broke with ½ mile of road yet to finish. Holmes: they used our roller before and it broke and they refused to help repair it. *Consensus* to not loan Sullivan Township the road grader. Combs: ground hog caused damage on Stewart Road and set trap.

RECYCLING- Rollin: need envelopes for recycling, repaired Aluminum trailer.

EMPLOYEES- *Motion* by Lamb with a second by Holmes to terminate employment of Aaron Ramsey. Roll call: three yeas.

PREVIOUS BUSINESS:

Lanning: ARPA grant application and previous documents sent to Commissioners. Letter of support sent to Lorain County Public Health for grant "safe streets and roads for all".

NEW BUSINESS:

Lanning: received email from Poznako about old "Herrick" tree on West Road that anyone can take pictures before it is cut. Holmes: put it on Facebook. *Motion* by Rollin with a second by Lamb to file no objections to Ohio Department of Commerce Liquor permits. Roll call: three yeas. Email from Paul Miller on Stewart and
