## July Block of the Month: Double Nine-Patch

Block finishes at 12" (unfinished at 12 1/2").
Materials:
4-17/8" $\times 20$ " strips of light color (A)
4-17/8" x 20" strips of dark color (B)
4-4 1/2" squares of the light fabric (C)
Construction:
Sew together the strips along long edges making one set A/B/A and one set $B / A / B$. From these strips, cut 10 A/B/A 1 7/8" wide units and $517 / 8$ " wide units.

Sew the units together to make 5
 Nine-Patch blocks. Press.
Measure and trim blocks to 4 1/2" square.

Sew the Nine-Patch and 4 1/2" squares (C) together into rows.


Press. Sew the rows together in checker board pattern with Nine-Patch blocks in the 4 corners and center and the $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blocks in between each. Press and measure. The finished block should measure 12 1/2" square.
***Remember your $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.***
You can choose to make a complete quilt top by repeating these instructions or you can set this block aside and make a sampler quilt. We look forward to seeing everyone's blocks.
