- Ensure players are on time for training, matches and events.
- Be encouraged to notify coaches of any medical or personal problems so that they may be acted on sensitively.
- Inform the club when players are not available for training, matches or events.
- All parents to have read understood and signed the club junior registration form.
- Be aware of the drugs policy within England Netball.
- Abide by the constitution of the club.
- Encourage good and fair play and respect opposing teams and supporters.
- Have realistic expectations of your child/children and be aware of their aims and goals.
- Accept the coaches and umpires decisions.

Parents or Carers are asked:

- Not to make negative or rude remarks to players, officials or other spectators.
- Not to coach players during competition.
- Not to smoke or drink alcohol around the court areas.
- Not to take photos or videos without the relevant permission being obtained.
- Not to put any derogatory, offensive or unsporting comments on any social network.
