

Notice to Customers of Cheat Mountain Water Company

Cheat Mountain Water Company and Shavers Fork Fire Rescue will be flushing the potable water distribution system during the period of May 1, 2016 thru May 21, 2016. It is normal for this procedure to cause temporary discoloration or cloudy appearance of the water and intermittent drops in water pressure. However, flushing is a necessary part of distribution system maintenance and protects the quality of the potable water supply. The discoloration or cloudy appearance of the water does not pose a health hazard. Fire hydrant flow testing is part of the procedure, which ensures the system's ability to provide adequate water for fire suppression. The system will be flushed on the following schedule:

North and South Village	May 1 – May 7
Village Center	May 1 – May 7
West Ridge and Silver Creek	May 8 – May 14
Hawthorne Valley	May 15 – May 21
Pocahontas Public Service District	May 15 – May 21

Severe weather or emergency may push any week back by a week.

We suggest that you refrain from color sensitive water uses, such as washing whites or filling hot tubs, while flushing is carried out in your area. Cheat Mountain Water Company and Shavers Fork Fire Rescue will not accept any responsibility for damages caused by low water pressure or the use of discolored or cloudy water.
