C. Long Beach Board of Education

The Long Beach Board of Education voted on April 12, to adopt the proposed 2022-2023 School Budget. The overall budget-to-budget change does have an increase from the current year. However, it will result in a 0% increase in the Long Beach Tax Levy. This means the district will once again not be asking the community for any additional money. The Board will put the budget up for a vote to the community on Tuesday, May 17, 2022. The community will have the opportunity to vote on the Budget and one School Board Trustee position.

C. Health & Safety Committee

The following items were discussed at the last Health & Safety meeting:

- 1. <u>HS IDs</u>: We are still waiting for ID's to be given at the HS; materials are in, but the machine is broken and we are waiting for the new one to come in so that the ID's can be printed. We also discussed the larger issue of having students wearing them and using them to get in and out of places. This would require an updated student management system, so the discussion will continue with the necessary parties.
- 2. <u>Lido Complex</u>: Paving is complete, but needs a seal coating before the lines can be painted. The entry way through the golf course is still a bit rough, because they will be re-doing their lot in the near future, so it was not worth re-paving right now. Additional signage will be put up as well. We discussed the new exit and the fact that cars going eastbound have to do the extra loop around, and that does not seem to be changing. In addition, we discussed the westbound exit having two turning lanes instead of one, to make traffic flow a little faster leaving. They will discuss with the architect and see if that is feasible. Once everything is completed, maps will be made and distributed to all parties, so that everyone is on the same page.
- 3. Points of Entry: There was a discussion about whether or not to keep multiple points of entry that we opened up due to COVID protocols. Although the plan will be to try to return to a single point of entry, each building will be looked at individually to determine the best course of action. Maybe having multiple points for arrival & dismissal and then single point throughout the day, with ID swipers for staff to use. Mr. DeVito and our BOCES rep will work with the principals to come up with a plan. The second problem is surrounding seemingly faulty actuators that were placed on all the newer dampers. These keep popping off the dampers, which causes the individual room to be an issue, and then a trickledown effect to the nearby rooms. This will be looked into by ECG to determine if these parts can be replaced or if there is some other fix.

- 4. <u>District-Wide Safety Plan</u>: There were 3 major updates to our plan that we discussed; the addition of a compliance checklist, notifications for parents/students/staff and updated guidance on responding to illness. All parties must be notified of all procedures before October 1st. We also discussed the timeline for approval of our DWSP. This meeting today was to discuss changes with the team, then there will be a Board Hearing and discussion, followed by posting the plan on the district website for the public to comment and give feedback. Finally, updates will be made, if necessary and then the Board would adopt the new policy, before September 1st.
