Mother Knew Best

Hate seeing weeds and hate using pesticides? I used to run to the store to buy various weed killers to stop those pesky grasses and weeds from growing between the pavers in our patio.

A few weeks ago, a friend came over and remarked, "You can just spray vinegar and salt to kill those weeds creeping out of your pavers." And then, on Facebook, someone posted a recipe for "Weed-Be-Gone," using vinegar, Epsom salt and Dawn dish soap. Someone at the pool said she just sprays straight vinegar on her weeds, and voila! Gone! I haven't tested each of these home remedies, but I sure like the idea of using an alternative to chemicals and saving money.

So here's the recipe I tried from www.naturalnews.com for "Weed-Be-Gone" 1 gallon vinegar 2 cups Epsom salt 1/4 cup Dawn dish soap

According to their website, it will kill anything you spray it on. Just mix and spray in the morning, after the dew has evaporated. Go back after dinner and the weeds are all gone! I only needed to make about a ¼ recipe, and it worked just fine. Bye, bye weeds!

Hopefully, the next time my friend stops by she will notice my "clean" pavers! And while we are thinking about all the uses for vinegar, I've also been told to mix equal parts vinegar and water in a spray bottle to get rid of ants.

Used coffee grounds and eggshells will add organic material to the soil in our flowerbeds and gardens, which improves drainage and water retention, and aeration. Used coffee grounds are neutral, whereas fresh coffee grounds are acidic. If you rinse your used coffee grounds, they will have a neutral pH of 6.5 and will not affect the acid levels of the soil. Rinsed, crushed eggshells add calcium carbonate, considered a secondary nutrient for plants; tomatoes and peppers are easily affected by calcium deficiency and appreciate the extra boost in minerals. Crumbled eggshells are also a deterrent for slugs and snails. Happy August gardening!



Enjoy this recipe for cheesy zucchini breadsticks for a great dinner side dish!

Ingredients:

3 cups shredded zucchini

3 eggs

1/3 cup flour

1 tsp salt



2 cups shredded mozzarella

Italian seasoning

- 1. Preheat oven to 450 degrees F.
- Sprinkle the shredded zucchini with salt to release some of its moisture. Let sit 10-15 minutes, then squeeze zucchini in a clean cheese towel to release most or all of the liquid.
- Mix zucchini, eggs and flour in a medium bowl. Spray a baking sheet with cooking spray and spread the zucchini mixture into a large thin rectangle.
- Bake for about 25 minutes or until the edges are nicely brown. Make sure it's nice and golden on the sides and top so the crust isn't mushy.
- Reduce the oven to 350 degrees F, sprinkle the crust with cheese and Italian seasoning, and continue baking until the cheese is just melted.
- Let cool a few minutes, then cut into sticks. Serve with marinara or ranch or garlic butter or any sauce your heart desires.
