Visit, we beseech thee, O Lord, this place of remembrance: Drive far from it all snares of the enemy; let thy holy angels dwell here to preserve us in peace, and let thy blessing be ever upon us. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

Almighty God, who hast given us grace at this time with one accord to make our common supplication unto thee; and hast promised through thy well-beloved Son that when two or three are gathered together in his Name thou wilt grant their requests (*Intercessions may now be made*): Fulfill now, O Lord, the desires and petitions of thy servants as may be most expedient for them; granting us in this world knowledge of thy truth, and in the world to come life everlasting. **Amen.**
