- Please complete every item on the application. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Obtain the initials of a Keller High School counselor to confirm your GPA

- Reference form may be completed by teachers, coaches, counselors, clergy, or individuals who supervised your community service.
- Reference form should not be completed by relatives or individuals with a direct conflict of interest.

Upon receipt of satisfactory evidence of enrollment/good standing, scholarship funds will be paid directly to college or university.
