A call list is included in this review. Call legislators based on the bill number and committee it is in. The Government Affairs committee has three bills that we want to address. The Industry and Labor committee has just one bill. Call legislators in the committee that the bill is in. You can speak about three bills at the same time to each legislator or their assistant that you call.

BILL	COMMITTEE	ISSUE THE BILL ADDRESSES
HB 22	Government Affairs	We want to ask that this bill Gets out of committee for a Vote on the floor. This bill allows voters to vote at any polling place in the county that they live in. This would make voting easier for all.
НВ 640	Government Affairs	This bill states that the President and Vice Presidential candidates must submit financial disclosures before they can get on Georgia's ballot for election.
НВ 650	Government Affairs	We want to push for a hearing of this bill. This bill allows each county to decide what statues they want to keep or remove from government property.
НВ 184	Industry and Labor	This bill is called the Pregnant Women's Fair Act. It protects The rights of pregnant women on The job. We want this bill to pass Industry and Labor Committee.

Our calls will be more effective.
