

CYRUS - CYDONIA MARTIAN MOTIF

The purpose of this illustration is to observe certain attributes of Cyrus the Great concerning the Cydonia, Mars pyramid complex. The study strongly suggests that based on the astro-archeological depiction of the area where Cyrus the Great is entombed in Pasargadae, the heart of ancient Persia, it appears that the area also encompasses the Martian pyramid pattern. The signature motif is comprised of 3 structures; the Face of Mars, the Giant Fortress and the Pyramid City complex. The learned of Cyrus' city architects were well-versed in the hidden knowledge of the Ancients before Genesis. They, like all other ancient civilizations in all continents used the same motif to layout their city sacred ley-lines. In this case of Cyrus' capitol, there was the ingenious double-overlapping depiction of the Orion constellation with the 3 Stars of Orion's Belt. It coincided with the Pyramids of Giza and the Cydonian pyramid complex. This ancient Martian motif is found in the whole of Earth's ancient building and royal compounds that are aligned to Cydonia, Mars in varying degrees of rotation and juxtapositions.

In the case of the correspondence between the Tomb of Cyrus and the Pleiades, there does appear to be an approximate delineation of the boundaries that match the Pleiades constellation. The lines that make up the current roads and angles have a striking similarity when viewing the Tomb complex from a top view. As noted in other studies and book by the title,

In the case of the design and layout of Cyrus the Great's capitol city, the Fortress of Cyrus corresponds to the D & M Pyramid. The site is very profound and upon the expansion of the dimensions from Mars, the approximate dimensions nearly match the size also in question on this earthly proportion layout. The 'Sphinx' structure that is now a heap of ruins has the approximated measurement of the Face of Mars, another apparent 'heap of ruins' due to the catastrophic effects of Mars losing its atmosphere in some spectacular celestial upheaval. The actual perimeter of the Face of Mars coincides with the perimeter that the 'Sphinx' structure that the building of some type was enclosed with. Amazingly, the approximate perimeter appears to match that of the Temple of Osiris next to the Sphinx in Giza.

Then the actual Tomb of Cyrus corresponds to the Pleiades constellation. In ancient recorded history, to have such structures as pyramids, tombs, and various land demarcations based on the ancient knowledge of the Anunnaki exemplified their esoteric and religious believe. It was understood that such a celestial frame of historical reference corroborated with their beliefs of where they came from. In general, such believed that their origins were 'seeded' by the 'god' that came down from 'heaven', more precisely Orion and the Pleiades.
