



New Fund Created to Help Families Facing an Emergency

The Charlotte Catholic High School Foundation has created a new fund to help families facing a financial emergency. The CCHS Tuition Assistance Fund was approved by the Foundation's Board of Directors after hearing about the need from CCHS Principal Kurt Telford. The funds are available immediately.

"If you ask people 'what makes Charlotte Catholic special?' They always say it's a family," said CCHS Foundation President Norm George. "We don't want any see any student have to leave our school because of an unexpected financial hardship."

Families who have children in good standing at Charlotte Catholic High School and are participating Catholics are eligible for assistance. Applicants can apply anytime during the school year with the CCHS Guidance Office.

"It was important to the board to make this available year-round," said George. "You can't plan for a job loss, a health crisis or a fire. We want to make sure we are doing everything possible to keep some normalcy for a family facing a crisis."
