- Over \$17 trillion is a common estimate of the cost. Virtually everyone agrees that amount could never be financed. Considering that reality, is just having the debate worth the inevitable result, i.e. increased division and racial bitterness rising to ever-higher levels?

We must ask ourselves: "What result do we expect? Are we being realistic? And are we being smart?"
