<u>Discussion and possible action regarding alternative dwelling communities and long-term camp parks</u> <u>pilot program</u> The board discussed the proposed county ordinance creating an overlay zone for long-term camp parks. Primarily, the board was concerned that GWSSA is charging an appropriate amount of impact fees for RV sites. There was discussion regarding whether an RV that is someone's residence should be charged an impact fee equal to that of a permanent residence. There was also concern over more illegal camping in neighborhoods in the district due to a lack of enforcement on behalf of Grand County and the ineffectiveness of a complaint-based enforcement model. The board directed Dana to write a letter to the County Commission outlining their concerns. Dana said she would attend the Planning Commission meeting on Monday.

Project updates Yoppify project is going well.

<u>Lake/Snow report</u> the lake has 1808 AF in storage the Snow-Water-Equivalent is 0. The YTD precipitation is 31.2 inches and 111% of average. The soil moisture is high, and the creek is still running.

<u>Items from staff</u> Dana attended the WRMP meeting. The engineers are still gathering data. There was a sanitary sewer overflow from the storm last weekend. Two homes and a trailer park were affected. Dana also attended a meeting with the county on the new USGS Groundwater Monitoring Network. GWSSA will not be directly involved with the input of the data, however, it is likely that several GWSSA wells will become monitoring wells for the project. The Army Corps of Engineers hosted a training on flood emergency planning and management. Dana and Ben both attended.
