What is a Catechist?

The entire Christian community has a common mission given to us by Jesus Christ – to make disciples. Some are called in a special way to be a **catechist**. The new Directory for Catechesis describes the catechist as “a witness to [the Church’s] living Tradition and a mediator who facilitates the incorporation of new Disciples of Christ into his ecclesial Body” (DFC p. 73). Essentially, a catechist actively lives the faith of the Catholic Church and accompanies new members into the body of Christ. The Directory describes the catechist as:

1. A witness of faith and keeper of the memory of God
2. A teacher and a mystagogue
3. An accompanier and educator

In the next three weeks we’ll briefly explore these three things and dive deeper into the vocation of a catechist.
