

Meet three women who faced the job of First Lady with grace, wit and courage. Based on the books *Betty Ford* by Lisa McCubbin (2018), *Pat and Dick* by Will Swift (2014), *Lady Bird and Lyndon* by Betty Boyd Caroli (2015) and *First Women* by Kate Andersen Brower (2017)

Queen Elizabeth II (portrayal)

Explore the life of longest-reigning monarch. Based on the book *Elizabeth the Queen* by Sally Bedell Smith (2011)





Titanic Survivor Violet Jessop (portrayal)

The story of the famed stewardess who survived the sinkings of the Titanic in 1912 and her identical sister ship, Britannic, in 1916. Based on the book *Titanic Survivor* by Violet Jessop (1998)


Bad Blood: The Rise and Fall of Elizabeth Holmes (lecture)
