## Books to Read:

Looking for some great books to read to your child to help build language and literacy? Go to your local library and check these out...

- 1 **The Dot** – Written and illustrated by Peter H. Reynolds: Like its sibling title, *Ish*, this award-winning book is about self-expression, creativity, taking risks, and making your mark.
- 2 **I am Rosa Parks** – Written by Brad Meltzer, Illustrated by Christopher Eliopoulos: “Kids always search for heroes, so we might as well have a say in it,” Brad Meltzer realized, and so he envisioned this friendly, fun approach to biography – for his own kids, and for yours. Rosa Parks dared to stand up for herself and other African Americans by staying seated, and as a result she helped end public bus segregation and launch the country’s Civil Rights Movement.
- 3 **Roaring Rockets** – Written and Illustrated by Tony Mitton and Ant Parker: Rockets have power. They rise and roar. This rocket's waiting, ready to soar. Rockets carry astronauts with cool, white suits oxygen helmets and gravity boots. Blast off with more out-of-this-world couplets! This time it is machines that fly. In bright and bold illustrations that are as witty as the text, the animal crew roars and whizzes into outer space.
