If last month's program inspired you to make your own home mayonnaise here is a recipe. (<http://goo.gl/g6SbpO>)

Ingredients

- 1 large egg
- 1 tablespoon Dijon mustard
- 1 1/3 cups vegetable or canola oil
- 4 teaspoons white wine vinegar or freshly squeezed lemon juice
- Kosher salt
- Freshly ground black pepper

Instructions

Combine the egg and mustard in the bowl of a food processor fitted with a blade attachment. Process until the mixture is evenly combined. With the processor running, slowly add the oil in a thin stream until completely combined. Add the vinegar or lemon juice and pulse until smooth. Season to taste with salt and pepper.
