Mark has served as Minister of the gospel for years in congregations in Sylvania, Georgia; Horseheads, New York; and Colonial Heights, Virginia. He currently serves as part-time minister for the LaSalle church of Christ in Niagara Falls, New York.

Mark was born and reared in Gahanna, Ohio. He enlisted in the United States Coast Guard after graduating from high school and served aboard an ice breaker as an Electrician's Mate. He came to know the Lord in December of 1978 while serving at a search and rescue station in Savannah, Georgia.

Mark graduated from David Lipscomb University with a degree in Bible and psychology. He holds an advanced degree in Adult Education and is a Doctoral candidate.

Besides his role as a Minister of the Gospel, Mark worked for many years as an Adjunct Professor of Psychology at Virginia State University and Richard Bland College. He has also been involved in numerous community volunteer groups, serving as a Chaplain in a regional jail, Chaplain for the police dept., Meals on Wheels and instructor of life skills at a homeless shelter. Mark was also involved for many years as director of Camp Agape. He has preached at gospel/youth meetings in Tennessee, New York, Pennsylvania, Virginia, and Ontario.

Mark and his wife, Audrey (Oliver) have been married for 37 years.

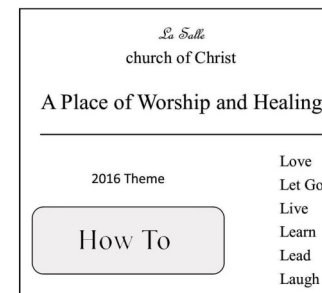


**We welcome all who are here today.**
