Our Hope of Heaven

"...we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord."

2 Corinthians 5:8

In our Sunday evening Bible study on the topic of heaven, we have been learning that heaven involves a series of developments for us Christians. The assurance from this passage from Paul is that death for us means being at home with the Lord. Jesus called our future home Paradise when He promised that destination to the believing criminal on the cross. That term was a Persian word which referred to a cultivated garden. In the incident known as the Transfiguration Peter and James and John saw Jesus conversing with Moses and Elijah. This indicates that believers in the afterlife are recognizable and that they have meaningful communication. That reality is reinforced when Jesus tells the story about Lazarus who goes to heaven and is communicating with Abraham. He is recognized by the rich man.

Nevertheless there is something that changes about our form of being at the rapture of the church. In 1 Thessalonians 4: 13-18 and 1 Corinthians 15 Paul says that we will receive a resurrection body. Our basis for understanding of that is the resurrection body of Christ. After His resurrection He had a physical form. He was able to eat. Yet he suddenly appeared and disappeared. First Corinthians #3 suggests that at this time we Christians will receive a judgment of rewards. Romans 8 v. 1 says that we Christians don't have to worry about any condemnation. But 1 Corinthians #3 indicates that we will be rewarded in some way according to our faithfulness in our earthly lives.

After a seven year tribulation described in Revelation 6-18, Jesus will return physically to earth. Revelation #19 describes us saints as joining with Him in that return and in confronting the forces of the evil one. It is then that Jesus establishes His physical rule upon the earth with his headquarters in Jerusalem. In Revelation #20 vv. 1-6 this earthly kingdom is said to last for a thousand years. Verse 6 specifically says that we "will reign with Him for a thousand years." In our resurrection bodies we will assist the Lord Jesus Christ in ruling over this earthly kingdom. Satan is bound in the abyss during this time. The prophet Isaiah gave us a glimpse of this wonderful time in Chapters 2, 11, 25, 60 and 65.

According to Revelation #20 vv. 7-10 Satan will be released from his prison at the end of this thousand years. He will lead a rebellion against Jesus. The Lord will defeat these evil forces and send them into the lake of fire. Second Peter 3 vv. 10-13 and Revelation 21:1 indicate that there will be a fiery cleansing of the earth. A new heaven and a new earth will emerge. Revelation 21:1 says that the new Jerusalem descends from heaven. This is described as a city in the shape of a cube. This is apparently our eternal home. According to Revelation 21:4 there is no more sorrow and no more pain and no more death. People still seem to maintain their ethnic identity (22:2). There will be meaningful activity. Revelation 22:3 says that we will serve God. Verse 4 says that we will see His face directly. It is all going to be really, really good.

As the day of our earthly death draws closer, don't be discouraged. The process of passing out of this earthly life may be tough, but the future for us who have believed in Jesus is really, really great.




