The May tournaments were scheduled for Lake Ouachita Friday May 6th, Wild Card Tuesday May 17 and Lake Hamilton Wednesday May 25th. Due to the forecast for bad weather on the 25th the tournament was rescheduled to June. June tournaments will now be a Wild Card Thursday June 2nd, Lake Hamilton Monday June 13th and Lake Ouachita Thursday June 30th. Best produc-

ing baits in the 5/6 tournament on Lake Ouachita were a green pumpkin trick worm on a jig head (top right) used by Dave Keith to win the Angler division and a green pumpkin centipede on a jig head (top right). The May 17th Wild Card tournament saw members having success using several different baits. Kirk Bixler took first place in Anglers division using a Carolina rig (lower left) and a drop shot rig (lower left). Other baits that were successful included a darter head jig with a salt and pepper dead ringer (upper left) and a Ned rig (lower center).
