COMFORT ONE ANOTHER

When one is going through various difficulties, problems, sickness, or death, they need encouragement from their brothers and sisters in Christ. Those who are not Christians who go through these things need love and encouragement, as well. In fact, such situations are wonderful opportunities to show that we care, and to share the gospel.

Jesus had great compassion on those who were troubled and downtrodden. He was there with his good friends, Mary and Martha, when their brother Lazarus died. Jesus wept with them (Jn. 11:35). He also reminded them that their brother would rise again and that those who believed in Him would never die (Jn. 11:23, 25). Jesus then commanded Lazarus to come back to life, and he did (Jn. 11:43-44). Jesus was there for what would have been his funeral, if not for the miracle He performed.

Jesus also showed His compassion when he came to the city of Nain. As He was entering the city, a dead man was being carried out. He was the only son of his mother, and she was a widow (Lk. 7:11-17). Jesus told the woman not to weep. No doubt, it broke Jesus' heart to see her in such distress. He then went and touched the open coffin and said, "Young man, I say to you, arise." Can you imagine the joy his mother must have felt?

Though we cannot give this amount of comfort to those who have lost loved ones, we can be present at the funeral to give them a hug and let them know we will be there if they are in further need.

Death is a harsh reality. God knows we need each other during this time. This is why inspiration says, "Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep" (Rom. 12:15).
