(Adapted from a prayer of confession found in the United Methodist Church Hymnal)

We have valued certain voices, perspectives, and bodies above others. We have not heard the cry of the needy, when we overlooked the hungry, the poor, and the outcast; when we turned our back on the one who was lost; when we chose for ourselves who was welcome at your feast. Even when we fail to seek forgiveness, and have not yet forgiven one another, forgive us, we pray. In Jesus' name. Amen

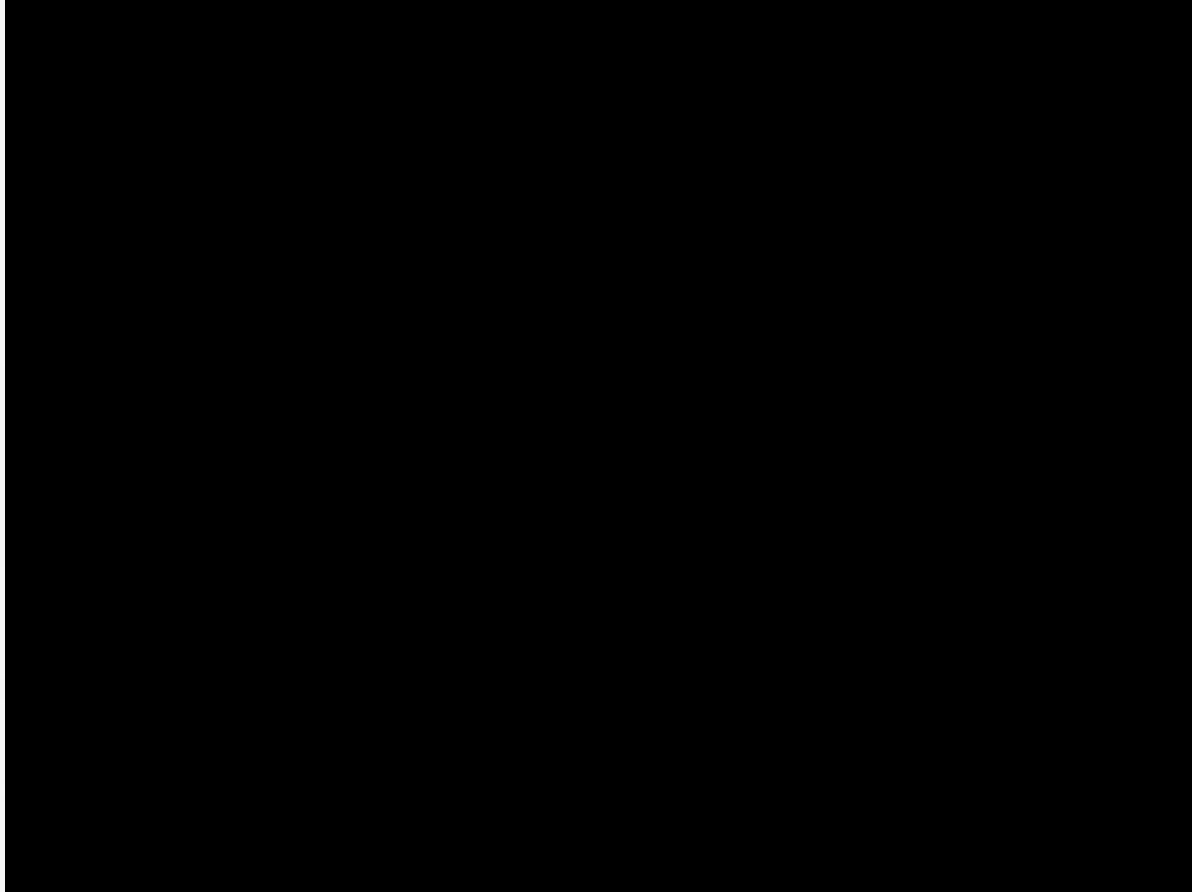

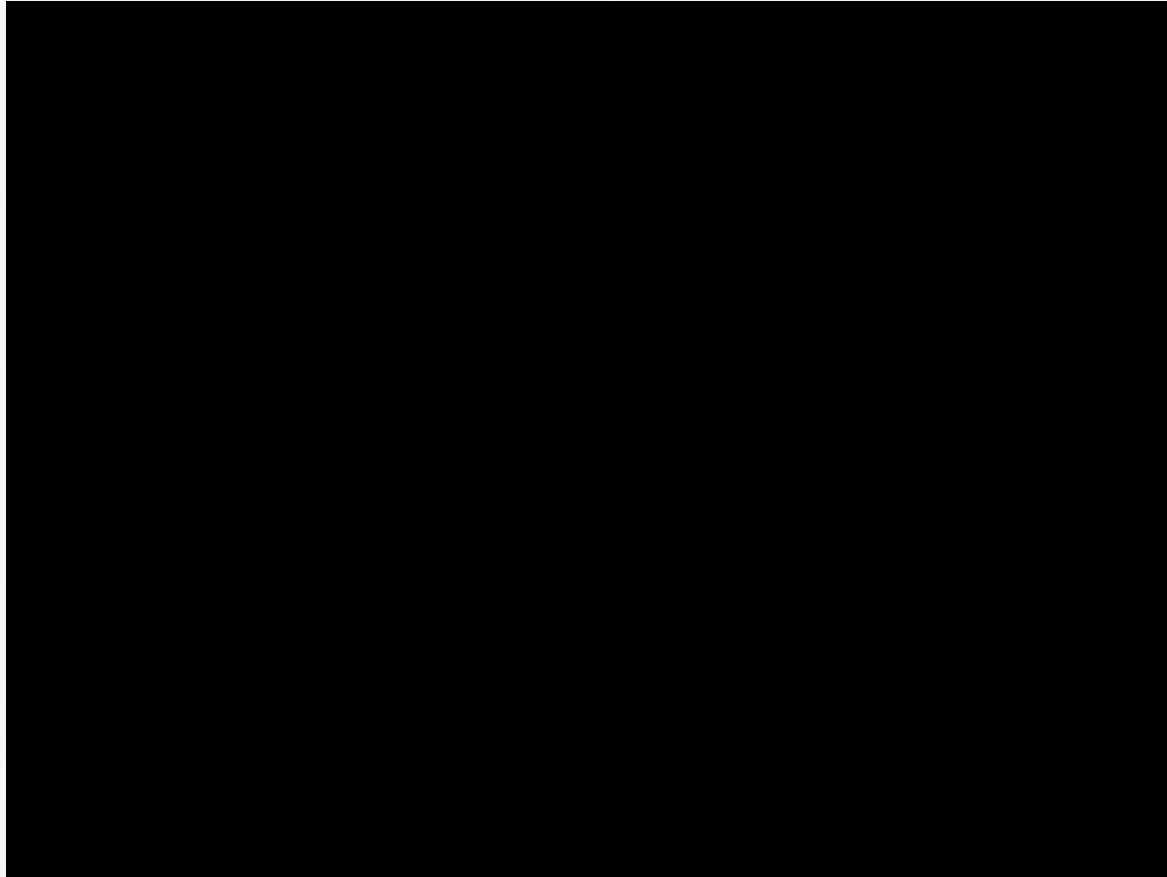
