Friday 22 October, 5:30pm to about 8:00-ish. MAP 1.

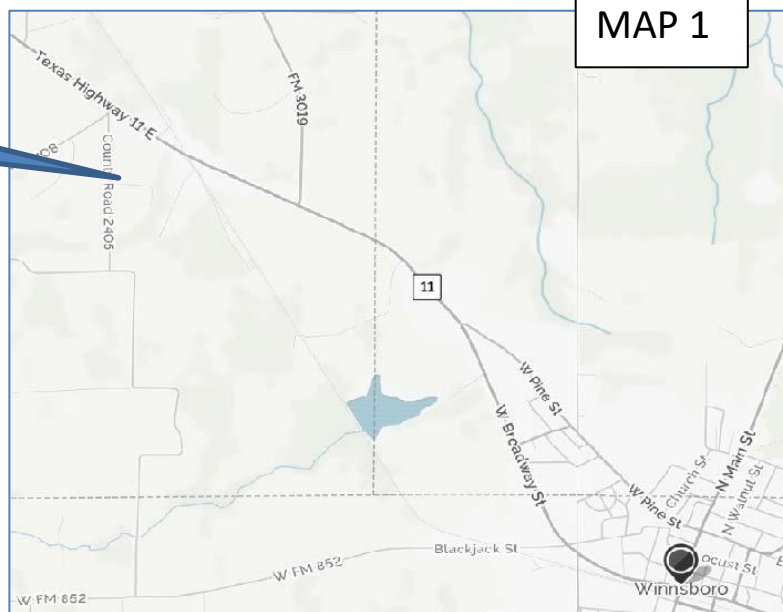

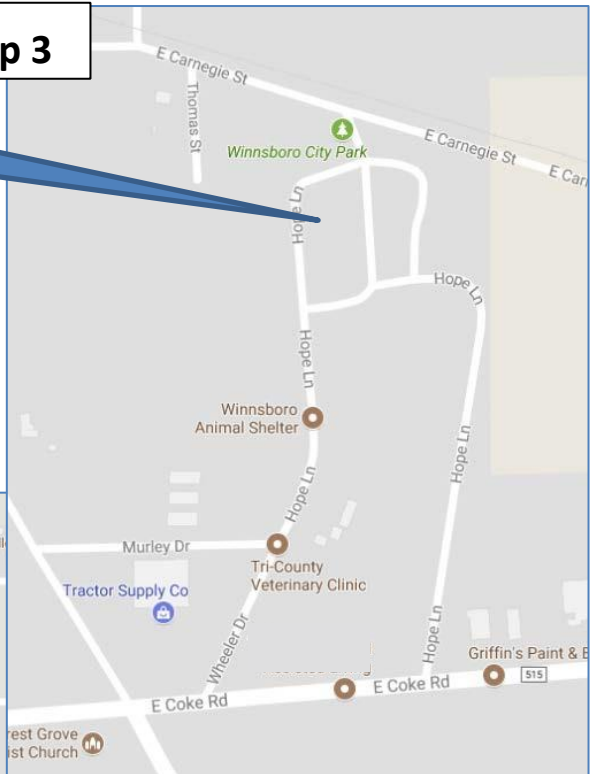
