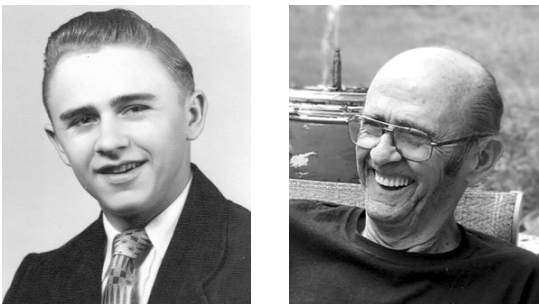
Fill out wish list applications at the Two Harbors Moose Lodge on Wednesday, November 4th, from 11:00 AM - 7:00 PM.

Paul W. Schmitz, 81, Two Harbors, died on Tuesday, October 6, 2020 at St. Luke's Hospital, due to complications of a stroke.
