They are only valid if we act upon them. I would like to remind you of the two resolutions: An Invitation to Encounter and Upholding the Dignity of All.

An Invitation to Encounter:

Be it resolved that with hearts full of devotion, humility, and love, we respond to Christ's invitation to enter into a relationship with Him and accept all he provides for us through his sacrifice, resurrection, and love and

Be it further resolved that we reflect on "a powerful moment in our life of faith" when we found the Lord and felt Him near, and to remember to listen to and support others' encounters with Jesus; an

Be it further resolved, that through charity, example, courage, and prayer, we invite others to conversion and to their own encounters with the Lord.

Upholding the Dignity of All:

Be it resolved that the Salt Lake Diocesan Council of Catholic Women (DCCW) will become educated on the needs of those who are caught up in the criminal justice system and of their families; and

Be it further resolved; that as violence is often a sign of deprivation and despair, our response, as women of faith, should be to address the root causes of crime and

Be it further resolved, that the members of DCCW will support the formation and mission of prison ministry pastoral leaders and volunteers with our prayers, our time, and our financial resources.

Hopefully your CCWs and individuals have already started applying the resolutions in their groups and in their personal lives.
