ARE YOU READY FOR WINTER?

We want you and your family to be prepared and know what to do before, during, and after a winter storm. Be sure to know your risks, listen for emergency information from local officials, and pay attention to weather reports.

Winter storms such as blizzards, extreme cold, freezing rain, snow, ice, and high winds, can be very dangerous. They create a higher risk for frostbite and hypothermia. To reduce the risk of frostbite and hypothermia, learn the signs & symptoms, limit your time outside, and wear warm clothing. A winter storm can last for hours or several days, and it can cause power outages to your home causing you to lose heat and communication. Get prepared NOW!

To prepare for a winter storm in your home, be sure to install and test smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, learn how to keep pipes from freezing, and create emergency supply kits for your home, workplace, and car.

ALL ABOUT REGION 5 MRC

Region 5 consists of MRC Units from the Naugatuck Valley, Torrington Area, Pomperaug District, and Danbury. All 4 units have been busy activating medical and non-medical volunteers for multiple COVID-19 vaccination clinics; COVID-19 booster clinics; and COVID-19 school-based vaccination clinics for 5-11 year-olds. Medical and non-medical volunteers have also been staffed at multiple seasonal influenza clinics! Medical volunteers have been activated to administer flu/ COVID-19 vaccines and non-medical volunteers have been activated to assist with traffic flow inside the clinic, help with forms and registration, and monitor supply levels of PPE and vaccine station equipment. MRC volunteers have been an essential part of these clinics.

DANBURY MRC

Danbury MRC has been activating medical and non-medical volunteers for seasonal influenza vaccination clinics. They are also hosting current and ongoing Pediatric Pfizer vaccine clinics for children 5-11-years-old. These pediatric clinics are being held twice a week and are also assisted by medical and non-medical MRC volunteers.

Danbury MRC volunteers have been participating in trainings offered by our Region 2 partners; ICS Training and a Opioid Awareness & NARCAN Training. Thank you Region 2 for the invite!

Additionally, Danbury MRC has two upcoming events. They will be hosting a Mass Pediatric Pfizer Clinic on December 11, 2021 and will need medical and non-medical MRC volunteers to assist. They will also be hosting a CERT training sometime in January/ February of 2022! Be on the lookout for these events!

POMPERAUG DISTRICT MRC

Pomperaug MRC (PHDMRC) has been busy this fall offering trainings to MRC volunteers and utilizing medical and non-medical volunteers to staff multiple influenza and COVID-19 vaccination clinics. Our medical volunteers have also staffed our weekly blood pressure screening events held at local Senior Centers within our District: attendance has been brisk!

Pomperaug MRC also hosted a CPR Refresher training in partnership with Woodbury Ambulance. This CPR Refresher was facilitated by EMT Dan Fennessy, who is also an Emergency Management Director for the Town of Woodbury and at the CPR training Dan administered the MRC Loyalty Oath to attendees.

TORRINGTON AREA MRC

As Our Nation continues to recover from the COVID-19 Pandemic we have made it our focus and are committed to working with local providers, and community partners to support continued vaccine efforts.

TAHD MRC volunteers have and continue fully staffing vaccine Booster clinics every Wednesday with support from both medical and non-medical volunteers. Our volunteer engagement over the past year maintained strong during the initial vaccine clinics and our volunteers assisted in vaccinating over 10, 275 individuals within the Northwest region of Connecticut.

In honor of the volunteers who have actively served their community and assisted with the covid vaccination clinics within the past year were invited to an Appreciation luncheon hosted by the TAHD held on August 25th.

MRC Volunteers supported TAHD and hosted community education presentations for topics regarding; Mental Health during the COVID19 Pandemic, Opioid Crisis, recognition and response, Emergency Preparedness in the Home, STOP the BLEED, and Hands-only CPR.



NAUGATUCK VALLEY MRC

In September, Naugatuck Valley MRC (NVMRC) and NVHD offered a combination live and virtual Psychological First Aid (PFA) training to MRC volunteers. This training was facilitated by Kathryn Dean, MSSW. Volunteers acknowledged how the instructor was very knowledgeable and the information provided to them was relevant and helpful! There was outstanding attendance from volunteers in both Region 5 and Region 2. Throughout the month of September, NVHD and NVMRC also hosted an Emergency Preparedness Art Contest. We partnered with our six school districts to promote this contest and we received art submissions from over 80 students in grades K-12th grade!

In October, NVMRC partnered with a local senior center to set up a table to promote senior preparedness and the MRC to attendees of the Health Fair. Volunteers were also activated to assist in administering flu and Pfizer vaccines at a Health Fair. Also during October, our PHEP and MRC Coordinator organized for NVHD employees to participate in a National Earthquake Drill called, "The Great ShakeOut!"

Additionally, throughout the year NVMRC has partnered with NVHD, Griffin Hospital, and local school districts to conduct COVID-19 and flu clinics. NVHD & NVMRC have hosted several schoolbased clinics for staff, and Pfizer vaccine clinics for students. With only a few clinics left on our schedule for the remainder of 2021, we recognize that we would not have been able to make all of these clinics possible without the help of our volunteers!
