As a note for the record, several previous emails to Glenn requesting that they email us the invoice ahead of time so that the policy can be paid at the next meeting. Glenn insurance assured us that even if the invoice is received mid-month and the payment made at the next scheduled meeting is after the due date, we will continue to have insurance coverage without a lapse.
