#### DONATION REQUEST

We are less than a month away from a wonderful Recovery EVENT! The Arizona Serenity in the Desert Intergroup (ASDI) is hosting the Region III Assembly and Convention August 8, 9, & 10 at the Tempe Mission Palms in Tempe, Arizona. You can find the registration form on the home page along with more information on the OA website at <a href="http://www.oaphoenix.org">www.oaphoenix.org</a>.

OA Meeting groups are being asked to donate items to raise money for ASDI and Region III. What can your group do? Perhaps toss a few pieces of program literature and a little something that has touched your recovery, a journal, a bookmark, something hand made from one compulsive eater to another. Put it all together in a basket or a box. Or pick up a gift certificate or a gift card. Examples: OA literature, fuel or grocery (please avoid restaurant gift cards due to the nature of compulsive eating). If your meeting is not able to put together a basket, you as an OA member may want to donate something. One member donated 2 brand new power tools: a leaf blower and a chain saw! Check through your closets and perhaps you will find some birthday or Christmas gift given to you but will never use. Rather than re-gifting think about donating it to the convention for the raffle.

For those members who have not attended a convention before, the way the raffle works is that the raffle items will be displayed in one of the convention rooms for your viewing with a container in front of it. Tickets are \$1 each (or 20 for \$15), you write your name and phone number on the ticket then place it in the container of the item that has caught your fancy. You can put all of your tickets in one item container or you can spread them around to other items you are interested in. A silent auction will also be used on items being donated.

In addition, we will have a 50/50 raffle. Tickets will be sold and one ticket will be drawn and the winner gets 50% of the pot and ASDI/Region III get the other 50%. So you have a chance of walking away with cash.
