Creston Accommodations:

There are several hotels/motels to choose from. Here are some recommendations:

1. **Creston Hotel** - 22 available rooms. 7 are kitchenettes. The rooms are all re-done, and the hotel has a cold beer and wine store as well as a dining room and pub. The kitchenettes have a separate bedroom with a queen size bed, and a hide-a-bed in the living room. It is within walking distance to the recreation complex and in the middle of downtown. Rooms are equipped with ironing board and iron, blow dryer, coffee maker. The hotel has been renovated and is extremely nice inside. There is a security door. 2. **Skimmerhorn Inn** – 25 rooms, most beds are queen size. This Inn is a motor hotel, and all rooms are accessible from outside. These rooms are tastefully re-done, and very clean. The rooms have coffee makers, and most have a fridge. 9 rooms are suites (kitchenettes) with 1 queen bed, a double bed and a hide-a-bed. Irons and blow dryers are available upon request. They offer coupons for “MONROES” (a restaurant) for 10% off.
