

Race City USA

On Friday, July 2nd, Cindy and I traveled from Florida to Elkin, NC for the marriage of James Magee and his new bride, Colleen. James is the son of club members and good friends Jim and Justine Magee. Traffic was horrendous, especially through Charlotte, but we arrived in time to join family members for the rehearsal dinner. The wedding was planned for the next day at 6pm, so I asked Jim what he was going to do all day. He answered "I don't know, what are you going to do?" I said I was driving to Mooresville, NC to take in the North Carolina Auto Racing Hall of Fame. Jim replied "I'm going with you!" Justine's only warning was to make sure he was back by 3pm! No problem!

The next morning we took the 50 mile drive south on I-77 to exit 36, and the Hall of Fame was just 5 minutes away. After driving by the signs for many years on trips to Florida, but not having time to stop, this was a treat. The museum features over 45 race cars dedicated to all types of auto racing, but mostly stock cars. Cars driven by Rusty Wallace, Darrell Waltrip, Tim Flock, Rex White, and Ryan Newman were just a few of the examples displayed. There is a tremendous memorabilia collection, including hundreds of scale model race cars, many of them hand built.

There is an art gallery featuring many of motorsport's top artists, a movie theater running a constant loop of some of racing's top moments, and of course a gift shop. There is really too much to list, it is well worth a couple hours of one's time while traveling on I-77. The museum is staffed and run entirely by volunteers, and most of the displays have been donated by former and current race car drivers and owners, fans and collectors, and other friends of the sport. Very impressive!

Mooresville is touted as Race City USA, and for good reason. The city is home to many race shops, racing museums, and race themed restaurants and attractions. Many NASCAR drivers, owners, and crew members also call this area near Lake Norman their home. At the museum and many other locations, one can pick up the Visitors & Race Shop Guide, listing venues you can visit, dine, and stay for a day or two. Info can also be found at www.racecityusa.org.

As luck would have it, across from the museum was DC Classic Cars Consignment & Sales. We couldn't very well pass up this 40,000 square foot indoor air conditioned treasure! The building was chock full of classics, hot rods, and customs for sale in all price ranges, it was another hour or so well spent. Check it out at DCClassicCars.com.

Oh yeah, the wedding! Jim got back in plenty of time to get ready for pictures, and everything went off without a hitch. The entire event was held at a quaint country winery with an outdoor ceremony, and the reception was held in their open sided pavilion with plenty of food, drink, and dancing.
