## Quilt block 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished



Color way: Scrappy

Bright Colorful Fabric A

Mixed grays for Background Fabric B

You will need

1 each color (4) – 2 1/2'' x 2 1/2'' bright colorful squares (Fabric A)

1 each color (4) – 2 1/2'' x 6 1/2'' bright colorful rectangle (Fabric A)

1 each color (4)  $- 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " bright colorful rectangle (Fabric A)

 $4 - 2 \ 1/2'' \ x \ 2 \ 1/2'' \ gray \ background \ squares \ (Fabric B)$ 

 $4 - 2 \frac{1}{2''} \ge \frac{1}{2''} \ge \frac{1}{2''}$  gray background rectangle (Fabric B)

## Quilt block construction:

With a 1/4" seam allowance:

- 1. Sew fabric A 2.5" sq to gray fabric B 2.5" sq together .
- Sew one 2.5" x 4.5" rectangle of your background and print A fabrics along the long side. Assemble the two pairs so that the prints are next to each other. Stitch the last rectangle (print B) to the rest so that it's next to the print A rectangle.
- 3. Repeat 3 more times changing the prints as needed, then assemble as a 4 patch, spinning the small block to match the prints.
