**DESCRIPTION:**

**REQUIREMENTS TO MAINTAIN MEMBERSHIP:**

Any student having below a 3.800 GPA, or any student who does not have the required 10 service hours, will be advised in writing of his/her standing and will have one semester to restore the minimum standards before dismissal. Any NHS member who receives office referrals, including being tardy, will be informed in writing that he/she is on probation for one semester. During probation, other referrals result in dismissal. Academic dishonesty or school suspension results in dismissal. Juniors who do not fulfill the required service hours will be dismissed after school is out. Seniors who do not fulfill the required service hours will be dismissed at the beginning of second semester.
