Sir, may I talk to you for a few minutes about your soul?

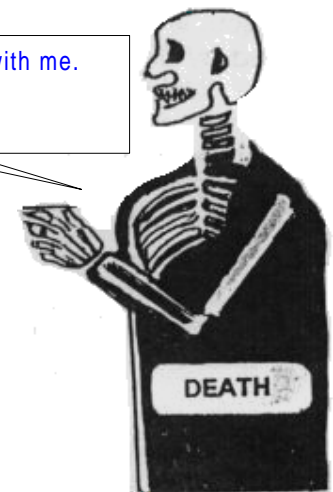
No, I am very busy now
