Classification: NRA classification will be used. Unclassified competitors will compete in Master class.

Rules: NRA Highpower Rules, Current edition will govern through out the tournament. No coaching will be permitted, **Challenges:** A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge and will be returned if the challenge is The scoring gauge will be restricted to the pit officer or NRA referee.

Rifles: NRA Service Rifle 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3, 3.1.4. Match Rifle 3.3, 3.3.1.

Sighting Shots: 2 sighting shots will be allowed per match

Match Schedule: 10: 00 AM. NRA Regional 80 shot course. 20 shots standing slow fire, 20 minutes, SR Target; 20 shots, 2 Strings rapid fire sitting or kneeling 60 seconds each, SR Target; 20 shots, 2 strings rapid fire prone 70 seconds each, MR42 target; 20 shots slow fire prone 20 minutes, NM-52 target; . All courses of fire will be at 200 yds.

Awards: The State Championship will be awarded to residents only, with an appropriate award to non-residents.

There will be a State Championship awarded in Service Rifle Category and in Match Rifle Category.

NRA award points, cash, or medals, minimum 70% of entry fees will be returned in awards. Awards will be provided for first place overall, and class awards—for each 5 or more entries in a class. Sponsor reserves the right to combine classes with less than 4 entries, in the most appropriate manner. If there are junior competitors, the award will be governed by SDSSA Junior awards policies, will be posted.

General Information: Competitors will be required to score, and
