Action 01: Financial Update

The total collection, including a previous balance in the General Account amount to \$5626.69 and the total expenditure is \$1379.33. The current balance in General Account as of August 2019 is \$4,247.36. The entire collection in Nepali Education Account (NEA) with a previous balance is \$13,742.39, and the expenditure is \$0.00. Therefore, the current balance in NEA is \$13,742.39. The total collection with a prior balance on Temple Account as of August 2019 is \$172,351.57, and the expenditure of the month is \$23,296.31. So, the Temple Account has a balance of \$149,055.26.

Action 2: Page Road Property

Board of Directorates agreed on adding/buying the property at Page Road, Harrisburg (Pennsylvania), that is attached to Nava HariHar Dham on page road. The property is attached to the OHRC temple site. Mr. D P Siwakoti table the proposal to add the property. Mr. Siwakoti explained that the property could be utilized as a meeting place and small gatherings sites in the current situation. Per Mr. Siwakoti, in the future, this property can be used for the guesthouse/ cafeteria after the completion of the Nava HariHar Dham project.

Action 3: Grantors and Fundraising

Board of Directorates decided to invite at least twenty-five members to co-sign with OHRC to buy the property on Page Road, Harrisburg (Pennsylvania). The organization's members can voluntarily participate in the co-signing process. Furthermore, the board also passed the statement that the co-signers will not have any personal/individual rights to the property. Co-signer/Grantors can withdraw their approval at any time. Upon paid off the property, co-

signers/grantors will be released from their financial involvement. The existing board bears the right to make decisions regarding the property.

Action 4: Deepawali celebration

As always, OHRC planned to celebrate 2019 Deepawali by organizing a Deusi-Bhailo program. BOD agreed upon making at most two groups. Each group plays Deusi or Bhailo based on the invitation from the community members. As always, the OHRC culture and event management team decided to give prime focus on cultural exchange and teaching the youngster about the significance of Deepawali in Hinduism.

Action 5: Deepawali and OHRC-NEP

The board of directorate urged the OHRC-NEP team to teach the common theme of Deepawali to NEP students. It was intended to explain that the universal message of Deepawali, such as symbolizing the spiritual victory of light over darkness, good over evil, and knowledge over ignorance. Attendees of the meeting reached on the collective agreement to teach our youngster that the Deepawali is a time to reflect on life and make changes for the upcoming year. It is common practice that people forget and forgive the wrong done by others during Diwali. It is a time when people mingle about in joy and embrace one another. The session ended by wishing all attendees a warm and prosperous Deepawali.
