Ballet Term of the Month:

Epaulement [ay-pohl-MAHN] . *Shouldering.* The placing of the shoulders. A term used to indicate a movement of the torso from the waist upward, bringing one shoulder forward and the other back with the head turned or inclined over the forward shoulder. The two fundamental positions of épaulement are croisé and effacé. When épaulement is used the position of the head depends upon the position of the shoulders and the shoulder position depends upon the position of the legs. Epaulement gives the finishing artistic touch to every movement

Did You Know?

- The Nutracker and the Mouse King was written by ETA Haffman. But it was a retelling by Alexandre Dumas that became the basis of the ballet.
- When The Nutcracker premiered at the Mariinsky Theatre in St. Petersburg on December 18, 1892, it was performed along with Tchaikovsky's one-act opera *Iolanta*.
- in 1944, The San Francisco Ballet became the first American Ballet to perform a full-length *Nutcracker*. Today, it is a holiday tradition, performed by hundreds of companies across the country.
