The Ride will be on August 19-20, 2023. The 38th Annual MS River Road Run is a motorcycle tour beginning at Moon Motorsports in Monticello, MN. The purpose of the MS River Road Run is to raise money to aid in the search for a cure for Multiple Sclerosis (MS). We ride for one reason, to help those with MS.

MS is a chronic, often disabling disease of the central nervous system. Most people with MS are diagnosed between the ages of 20 & 50, but the unpredictable physical and emotional effects can be lifelong. The progress, severity and specific symptoms of MS in any one person cannot yet be predicted, but advances in research and treatments are giving hope to those affected.

Nearly 1 million people are living with Multiple Sclerosis in the United States. The money raised goes to the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, Upper Midwest Chapter, Minneapolis, which is a non-profit, voluntary health organization dedicated to advancing the cure, prevention and treatment of MS.

With your support, the National MS Society has achieved as much progress in the last 5 years as the 70 that preceded it - changing all aspects of life for people affected by MS.

The Society has invested more than 1 billion dollars to fund MS research to get us closer to a cure.

Then we head to Jordon cruise along the MN River to Le Sueur and towards Waterville around the lakes and to St. Clair, MN and end at the Country Inn & Suites, Mankato for the night.

There will be a banquet with a silent auction and live auction to raise money to help fight MS. If anyone would like to join us at the banquet, tickets can be purchased separately for the dinner.

Sunday we will ride to the Twin Cities area before heading home.

This year's route was designed by Carl and Denise.
