

Dr. Cornelius Tilton



Rev. Cornelius Tilton pastors the Irish Channel Christian Fellowship and has been their faithful leader for 29 years. He was called to the Irish Channel Christian Fellowship in May of 1988 on an interim basis and was unanimously elected Pastor in February of 1989. A call to proclaim God's word, he served God and his community in faithful and fulfilling service to God for thirty-seven years. Under his leadership, the Irish

Channel Christian Fellowship has grown numerically, and its annual budget has increased many times over. The outreach involvement of the church and its members has been expanded under his administration to several African, Caribbean and Central American countries.

Rev. Tilton, a native of New Orleans, is a graduate of Dillard University in Business Administration and French and Christian Bible College of Louisiana in Theology. He was also honored by Christian Bible College of Louisiana with a Doctor of Divinity degree. Dr. Tilton is currently serving as the President of Christian Bible College of Louisiana. Rev. Tilton served his community in various capacities as chairman of the Administrative Committee of the New Orleans Baptist Association, President of Dillard University Alumni Association-New Orleans Chapter, and leader of many boards and associations. He also serves as Chairman of the Foreign Mission Board of the Universal Baptist Convention of Liberia helping to strengthen a rural K-12 educational system, including Ebola orphans. In 2018, the President of the National Baptist Convention of America International appointed him the Deputy Secretary of Missions for West Africa.

Rev. Tilton is married to the former Carolyn LeBrane. They have 4 adult children, eight grandchildren, and one great granddaughter.
