

From Interstate 64 West, take Exit 250B (Fort Eustis Blvd./Route 105) eastbound to Yorktown for 3 miles. Take a left on Route 17 North (George Washington Memorial Highway) for 1 mile to York High School on your right.

From Route 64 East, take exit 258B to Route 17 North (George Washington Memorial Highway). Travel approximately 10 miles from the Newport News/York County line to York High School on your right.

From Gloucester/Route 17 North travel 3 miles South of the York River Bridge to York High School on your left.

NOTE:




